#### **Grade 1 (Age 6–7)**

- Figh: Introduction to the Five Pillars, cleanliness, basics of wudu
- Aqidah: Belief in Allah and His qualities (e.g. The Merciful, The Provider)
- Seerah: Childhood of Prophet Muhammad عليه وسلم
- Ahadith: 5 hadiths focusing on truth, cleanliness, kindness
- Akhlaq: Respect, politeness, truthfulness, thankfulness
- Adab: Eating, drinking, using the washroom, sleeping etiquette
- Tareekh: Story of Prophet Adam (AS), Nuh (AS)
- Surahs & Duas: Memorization begins with short Surahs and Duas





#### **Grade 2 (Age 7–8)**

- Figh: Method of wudu, staying clean (istinja), introduction to salah
- Aqidah: Names of Allah, belief in angels and divine books
- Seerah: Youth and early adulthood of the Prophet
- Ahadith: 5 hadiths on salah, kindness, speech
- Akhlaq: Helping others, trust, kindness to animals
- Adab: Speech, greetings, entering a house
- Tareekh: Prophets Hud (AS), Salih (AS)
- Surahs & Duas: Continued memorization and understanding





# **Grade 3 (Age 8–9)**

- Fiqh: Detailed wudu, salah units (rak'at), types of impurities
- Aqidah: Allah's names, prophets, Hereafter
- Seerah: Revelation and early call to Islam
- Ahadith: 10 hadiths on truth, patience, life, guests
- Akhlaq: Speaking the truth, good character
- Adab: Du'a, Qur'an, walking respectfully
- Tareekh: Ibrahim (AS), Ismail (AS), Ishaq (AS)
- Surahs & Duas: More short Surahs, Duas with meaning





# Grade 4 (Age 9-10)

- Figh: Tayammum, salah for boys and girls, ghusl
- Aqidah: Qiyamah, signs of the Day of Judgement
- Seerah: Migration to Abyssinia, persecution
- Ahadith: 10 hadiths on mercy, modesty, guests
- Akhlaq: Forgiveness, kindness to parents
- Adab: Guests & hosts, gatherings, social interaction
- Tareekh: Yaqub (AS), Yusuf (AS), Musa (AS)
- Surahs & Duas: Continued memorization and tafsir basics





#### Grade 5 (Age 10-11)

- Figh: Sunan and makruh acts of salah, tarawih, Eid salah
- Aqidah: Major signs of Qiyamah in detail
- Seerah: Boycott, Year of Sadness, Isra' and Mi'raj
- Ahadith: 15 hadiths on dhikr, salah, good actions
- Akhlaq: Gratitude, helping others, spreading salam
- Adab: Ghusl, writing, siwak, visiting the sick
- Tareekh: Dawud (AS), Sulayman (AS), Yunus (AS)
- Surahs & Duas: Emphasis on meaning and application





# Grade 6 (Age 11–12)

#### **Separate Curriculum for Boys and Girls**

- Fiqh: Janazah (funeral rites), ghusl for deceased, salah of traveller/sick, impurity laws
- Aqidah: Life after death, Barzakh, resurrection
- Seerah: Migration to Madinah, Treaty of Hudaybiyyah
- Ahadith: 15 hadiths on truth, friendship, character
- Akhlaq: Avoiding gossip, modesty, avoiding hatred
- Adab: Moderation, personal hygiene, modest dress
- Tareekh: Islamic history introduction, Umayyads
- Surahs & Duas: Surah understanding, etiquette of supplication





# **Grade 7 (Age 12–13)**

- Figh: Imam responsibilities, missed salah, jummah salah
- Aqidah: Jahannam and its punishments, Asharah Mubasharah
- Seerah: Conquest of Makkah, Battle of Hunayn, Farewell Hajj
- Ahadith: 15 hadiths on repentance, salah with jama'ah, du'a
- Akhlaq: Rumors, value of time, knowledge, trust
- Adab: Adhan, oaths, technology use, walking with elders
- Tareekh: Abbasids, Andalusia, Crusades
- Surahs & Duas: Spiritual reflection through Surahs & Hadiths





# **Grade 8 (Age 13–14)**

- Figh: Business ethics, nikah, mahr, halal/haram foods
- Aqidah: Destiny (Qadar), evil eye, consultation with scholars
- Seerah: Final years of Prophet علي , role of Khulafa, mothers of believers
- Ahadith: 15 hadiths on humility, contentment, Islamic identity
- Akhlaq: Tawbah, modesty of gaze, sincerity
- Adab: Buyer/seller etiquette, community interaction
- Tareekh: Ottomans, Islamic contributions to civilization
- Surahs & Duas: Culmination of learning with deep reflection
